

# The Lincoln Bed

The handmade walnut bed that Abraham Lincoln as a boy of fifteen or sixteen made for his sister Sarah Lincoln Grigsby. It was given by her brother-in-law Nathaniel Grigsby to Judge Strother Grigsby's son James Grigsby in 1855, was in this home from 1860 until the 1980's when it passed into the possession of Dr. Don Grigsby.
